As agreed by learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representatives of the respondent-Insurance Company, a sum of Rs.12,50,000/- (rupees twelve lakhs fifty thousand only), over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant-Pawan Kumar.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a sum of Rs.12,50,000/- (rupees twelve lakhs fifty thouand only) by way of RTGS in the bank account of the appellant-Pawan Kumar. The details of the saving bank account shall be provided by learned counsel for the appellant to the learned counsel for the Insurance Company within seven days from today, failing which a crossed-cheque for the said amount in the name of the appellant-Pawan Kumar be deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, failing which interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount
